In the top grades we saw **Jude McGuire** from Talbot FNC take out the best and fairest in the Football followed closely by Lexton's **Tyler Richards**, while in the Netball we saw **Megan Wilson** from Newstead take out the Netball with Natte-Bealiba's **Sian Mortlock** coming in second.

'**Jude McGuire** is an outstanding on-ball player and has been very influential in the Hawks rise up the ladder to finish in second position after the home and away season.'

'**Megan Wilson** has been a standout player this year for Newstead. She is still eligible to play 15s but decided she wanted to play in 17s to improve her game. Megan has also stepped up and played A grade this year.'

In other grades we saw **Robert Muscat** from Maldon win the goal kicking with a massive 75 goals in an interrupted season. The 17's leading goal kicker was Talbot's **Jesse Hardiman** with a total of 31 goals.

'**Robert Muscat** has been a brilliant on-baller and was key to Maldon's undefeated season in which he kicked bags of fifteen and eleven goals.'

'Jesse Hardiman was recruited from East Point in 2021 and has played a significant role in Talbot's rise up ther ladder kicking thirty-one goals for the season.'

In the Under 11's Netball and Football we saw ties in both grades, with a three-way tie in the Football between Avoca's **Freddy Davis**, Carisbrook's **Harvey Rumpff** and Trentham's **Danny Sutton** and close behind was **Harry Bennett** from Lexton.

'**Danny Sutton** is a brilliant on-baller who is also strong around the goal mouth kicking fifteen goals for the season.'

'Harvey Rumpff polled in ten games for the season with seven best on grounds while also kicking 16 goals for the season and is a big reason in Carisbrook being top of the table.'

The Netball saw a two-way tie between Dunolly's **Mia Schodde**, and Talbot's **Louella Roche** and coming in a close second was Harcourt's **Maycee Rinaldi**.

Finally, the 15 and Under girls had Talbot's **Abbey Sealey** win the major prize with Royal Park's **Paige Walkley** following closely behind her.
