### Canteen & Bar Requirements:

**Canteen:** Trentham FNC | **Bar:** Navarre FNC

Canteen supplies must be purchased through Wattle City Meats (all meat supplies, incl hot dogs and sandwich meat) and bakery products from Hot n' Crusty Bakery (incl cakes and slices). For 2019 only drinks can be purchased through a local club sponsor

Bar supplies can be purchased through local suppliers but must be CUB products (beer: northern, draught, dry | cider: strongbow and little green). Bar's must only be provided during hours indicated on liquor license as supplied to the league.

## Ground Manager:

Ground manager will be provided by Trentham FNC to act on behalf of the League. Duties include collecting footballs from the office and supplying to umpires prior to each game, returning used game balls to the office, umpire escort, carrying water for BFUA umpires and ensuring Team Managers return sheets to the office after each game.

## Team Sheets / Results:

Each participating team is required to enter their team sheets online and generate team sheets as per the usual practice.

The League will enter results for each match. Please ensure your full results are handed to the MCDFNL representative after each match.

## Pre-Game & Post Game Presentations:

Games will be accompanied by pre game national anthems and post-game presentations. Please allow time for these in your preparations. Best on ground medallions will be presented to each game and junior netball games will also receive runner-up medallions.

## Filming:

## Matchday Requirements:

### FOOTBALL

#### CLUBS TO SUPPLY

During the finals series, the competing Clubs must supply the following:

- 1 x Timekeeper
- Cleaning of change rooms – fines apply for unsatisfactory cleaning of rooms post-game (must be cleaned after every match)
- Goal umpires for Weeks 1 & 2 for Under 11.5 Finals only
- Nominated team manager that the League ground manager can get best players and goal kickers from. (each competing Club per match must supply regardless of winning or losing)
- Trainers, Runner, Water carriers
- Stretchers

#### MCDFNL TO SUPPLY

During the final series, the MCDFNL will supply the following:

- Match Day paperwork – scorecards, report books, etc.
- Ground Manager (*from Club rostered for canteen who acts on behalf of League*)
- Club room allocations
- Football/Netball Advocate Records
- Gate Keepers
- Ground Inspection – MCDFNL will complete Match Day Checklist
- All match footballs and pump
- Umpires - Central, Boundary & Goal (except for Week 1 and 2 goal umpires for Under 11.5 matches)



## NETBALL

### CLUBS TO SUPPLY

During the final series, the competing Clubs must supply the following:

- 1 x Scorer
- 1 x Scoreboard Attendant
- 1 x Time Keeper

Please note: the above must be competent and experienced. We cannot have first time scorers during finals.

During the final series, the MCDNFL will supply the following:

- Netball Umpires
- Match Netballs & game day equipment
- Court Manager
- MCDNFL will complete Match Day Checklist

- \* Time on for Reserves, Under 17.5, Under 14.5 and Under 11.5 football Finals matches shall only be used in cases of serious injury requiring a stretcher or where the ball enters the lake and where “time on” is signaled by the Field Umpire for excessive time lapse i.e. the football cannot be returned to the field of play.

## Drawn Games:

### Football -

#### 39.16 Drawn Games in Finals Series – FOOTBALL

39.16.1 In the event of a drawn game in any Finals match (including the Senior Football Grand Final), the following shall apply.

39.16.1.1 The teams will change ends following a break of no more than three (3) minutes.

39.16.1.2 A five (5) minute quarter will be played (plus time-on) before immediately changing ends for another five (5) minute quarter (plus time-on). There is to be no break between these quarters.

39.16.1.3 For all grades of football, if at the end of the second five-minute quarter scores are still level, no change of ends will occur and play will be restarted at the centre bounce and the first score will win.

### Netball –

Please note the following clarification regarding netball drawn games

**83.4** During a final at the end of the game when scores are tied there is a two (2) minute break during which time there may be substitutions and / or team changes. At the end of the 2 minutes once the score has been verified, there are a further 2 halves played.

11 & Under	2 x 5 minutes	1-minute break
13 & Under	2 x 5 minutes	1-minute break
15 & Under	2 x 5 minutes	1-minute break
17 & Under	2 x 5 minutes	1-minute break
C grade	2 x 6 minutes	1-minute break
B grade	2 x 6 minutes	1-minute break
A grade	2 x 7 minutes	1-minute break

In the instance that a game is still tied at the end of these two additional halves, the game will continue until one team has a two (2) goal lead.

### Player Eligibility:

A final reminder that clubs are to ensure eligibility criteria has been met by all players. Disputes to be raised with Matt Lindsay prior to the weekend. Please refer to MCDFNL by-laws for eligibility criteria.



**Officials:**

Trainers, Runners & Water Carriers to be supplied by each competing club. Number of officials and officials uniform must fall in line with relevant MCDFNL by-laws.

Only persons authorized may enter the playing arena during the playing of a match and must remain within the marked area around the interchange box.

Clubs competing in the MCDFNL Senior competition are permitted to have up to 4 officials (including Coach, Asst Coach, Chairman of Selectors, etc.) within the marked confines of the Interchange box.

All officials, apart from Trainers and Water Carriers, are to remain seated in the coaches box at all times during play, or within the confines of the perimeter lines surrounding the Coach's Box. If no lines are marked, all must remain within the confines of the Coach's Box.

If there is insufficient space within the coach's box, or no box is provided, then remaining officials are to be situated outside the boundary fence. Trainers and Water carriers may be spread around the ground but must be positioned against the fence and not on the boundary line when at rest.

All other personal not mentioned above are considered unauthorized, and umpires have been instructed to remove them from the ground. Any Club desiring authorization of any other officials, must apply to the League for such authorization, prior the commencement of the fixture.

Coaches and their coaching staff who don't remain within the perimeter lines surrounding the coaches box will be penalised \$50 per offence.

**Code of Conduct:**

Each club is responsible for the behavior of their players, officials and supporters at any game in which their club participates.

There has been an alarming number of reports of breaches to our code of conducts. Remember that finals are a time for celebration and immense passion, but we are never to cross the line into abuse and violence. Only TOGETHER can we create an inclusive environment for all to enjoy the MCDFNL Finals Series.

**Melees:**

A reminder that ALL officials are not to enter into on-field melees. We will not remind clubs twice. This is an ongoing issue so all water carriers, runners, trainers, umpires are reminded to stay OUT of any on-field altercations.
